- No pre-registration required, no fee, entry gains free admission into the fair
- Bring prepared item, recipe form, and registration form
- Deliver to the Fair by 12:45PM on Friday, June 24
- Home & Hobby area on 2nd Floor, West end of Grandstand
- Judging starts at 1:00PM

Entry Requirements

No limit of entries per class
A minimum of 4 ounces of cheese
Plated on a disposable plate
Completed recipe form
Completed registration form

Tips and Strategies

- Test first with your friends and family
- Enter multiple classes and cheeses
- Don't provide more than 5 ounces
- Stack in lidded containers prevent smashing
- Refrigerate until the last minute
- Transport in a cooler
